Local 113 Scholarship Program

AWARDS:

Two \$500 tuition Scholarships and one \$1000 Cecelia Razook Memorial Scholarship for use at any accredited post-secondary institution. One \$500 Scholarship to go to further the education of a Local 113 member; and one \$500 and one \$1000 Cecelia Razook Memorial Scholarship to go to further the education of the son or daughter of a Local 113 member.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible applicants must be a Local 113 member in good standing or the son or daughter of a Local 113 member in good standing. Membership must be for three continuous years as of the date of the application deadline for the scholarship. There is one combination application form for the \$1000 Cecelia Razook Memorial Scholarship and the \$500 Scholarship for the child of a member. Applicants are not eligible to win multiple awards in any one given year. The Officers, Executive Board members, and staff of Local 113 are not eligible to participate in this program.

SELECTION OF WINNERS:

Winners are to be selected by lot. No academic performance standards or records required for eligibility. Submit only one application per person. Duplicate entries will be disqualified.

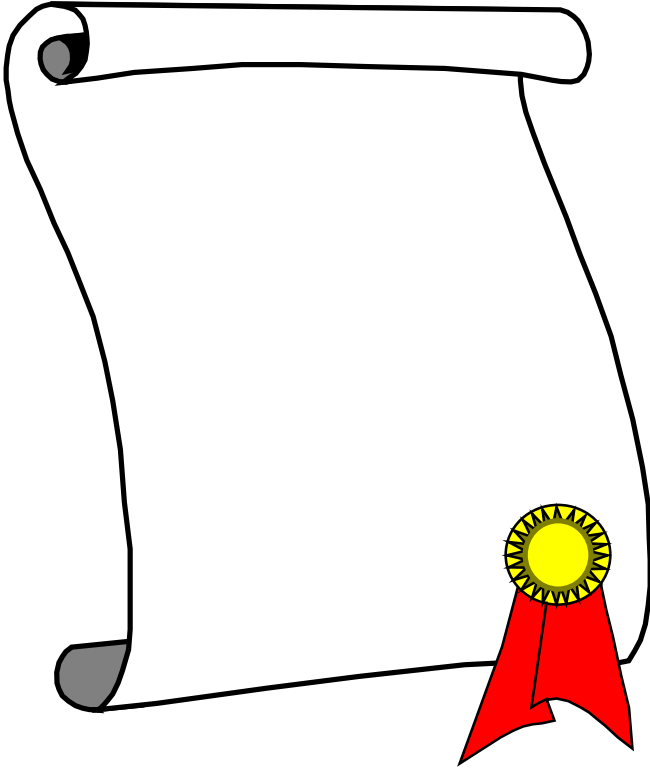
