TENTATIVE AGREEMENT REACHED

Last night, at 11:15pm after 15 hours of negotiations, the Union bargaining team and CRMC management reached a tentative agreement on a new 3-year contract.

The proposed contract meets many, but not all of our goals. We believe it represents the best deal possible short of a work stoppage and that the deal is substantially better due to the activity and engagement of the full membership at CRMC in support of our team.

We expect to be able to provide a summary of the terms of the agreement later today along with details for our contract ratification and voting processes. We will also provide the full text of the changes proposed for our contract by Thursday via email and website and voting will take place next week between 6am and 6pm on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Thank you for your support and encouragement over the past few months. It made a difference! We look forward to giving all members a chance to review the Tentative Agreement and to make your voice heard.
